

## Personal Data Information Duty

Four European projects, [AiRMOUR](#), [AURORA](#), [FF2020](#), and [USEPE](#) have launched a joint workshop to bring together different Urban Air Mobility (UAM) stakeholders to promote debate and foster the co-creation of meaningful services that create added value for society.

The Task Coordinator and the Data Protection Officer of AURORA are hereby referred to as the personal data administrator and controller (in particular the following UAM research activities e.g. documentation of discussions in workshops) of the participants.

The Task Coordinator and the Data Protection Officer shall process the following personal data:

- 1) pursuant to Regulation (EU) No 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) - GDPR;
- 2) pursuant to art. 6.1.(f) of GDPR, i.e. the projects' legitimate interest,
- 3) pursuant to art. 6.1(b) of GDPR for the purpose of the performance of the projects,
- 4) pursuant to art. 6.1(a) to collect consents provided for participating in the stakeholder/citizen engagement of the projects.

Personal data will be kept for the entire period necessary to perform the projects.

Rights of the data subject:

- 1) the right to access your personal data, i.e. the right to obtain confirmation whether the Task Coordinator or the Data Protection Officer process data and information regarding such processing, and to receive a copy thereof;
- 2) the right to rectify data if the data processed by the Task Coordinator and the Data Protection Officer is incorrect or incomplete;
- 3) the right to request the deletion of data;
- 4) the right to request restriction of data processing;
- 5) the right to object to the processing of data on the basis of legitimate interest;
- 6) the right to lodge a complaint with the Belgian supervisory authority: to the address of the Personal Data Protection Office: electronically on the website: <https://www.gegevensbeschermingsautoriteit.be/burger/acties/klacht-indienen>
